I HOW IT STARTED

1. Ten years ago our local community faced massive devastation of natural environment because government officials wanted to build highly destructive high power line 2 x 400 kV.
2. It meant destruction of approx. 50 houses, some of them recently built.
3. Free people concerned about the beauty of nature rebelled and created first organization „Ecological Wielkopolska”.
4. We started a campaign „No Devastation Without Consultation”
5. We built a coalition of NGOs, local activists, commune officials, journalists, politicians, farmers and businesses.
6. We won and the line was constructed without too much devastation.
First the old line was pulled down and then the new one was built in that place.



II WHAT WE DO

1. We monitor any threats to the environment, broadly speaking, not only what government regulations require.
2. We educate about Earth's biosphere, climate changes and means to preserve the nature. We encourage people to live according to these principles.
3. We work out practical means to mitigate climate changes.
4. Our activities are based on verifiable science – PCF Science Council groups reputable scientists from Polish universities.
5. Conferences, seminars and debates are important part of our activities.
So far we have organized approximately 50 such events and took part in 150.
6. We cooperate with relevant government bodies and other NGOs.







III THE OFFER TO THE SOCIETY

4. We promote local actions and activity in local population.
5. Central decisions must base on acceptance of local CEC.
